What are we testing ?

Connectathon is about checking the correct implementation of the IHE Profiles within your product. You are free to debug and recompile as many times as you need. Systems in any development state (from prototype to commercially released) are welcome.

Add your system

[Add a system](#)

Name: the system name is mostly used internally to your company. It stands for the name by which the system is known by your team.

Type: Help distinguishing the different types of systems (modality, work station, repository and so on)

Keyword: Uniquely identifies your system in the tool and during the event. Keyword prefix is based on system type and organization keyword.

Version: You might want to report the version of the product being tested.

Owner: Select a user from your organization as the main contact for any question related to this system.

Select what you want to test

Under the [Profiles/Actors tab](#) you will be able to select what are the IHE Actors you want to test at the event.

An entry with the NONE option will always be added to the list when you add an IHE Implementation. It is use to select the test cases of interest for your system.

Make sure you did not forget to select any IHE Implementation (based on IHE grouping requirements in some Profiles):

- "There are no missing dependencies for this system": You're done
- [Missing Dependencies Check Result](#) Click on this orange button to get the list of IHE Implementation you might add to your system to meet IHE requirements.
