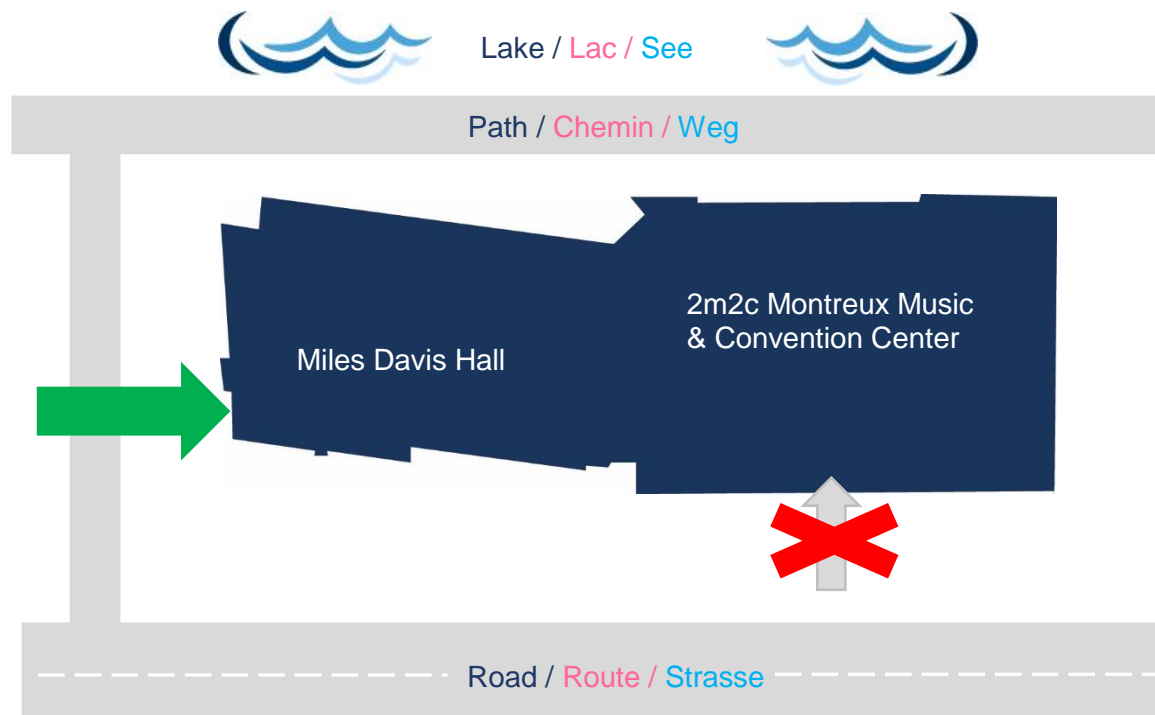


Where is the Miles Davis Hall ? Où se trouve le Miles Davis Hall? Wo befindet sich die Miles Davis Hall?

The eastern side entrance of the 2m2c Montreux Music & Convention Center leads directly to the Miles Davis Hall. Please **do not** use the main entrance of the 2m2c. A “Miles Davis Hall” sign and our welcome poster (see below) surmount the eastern side entrance. Please announce yourself at the welcome desk.

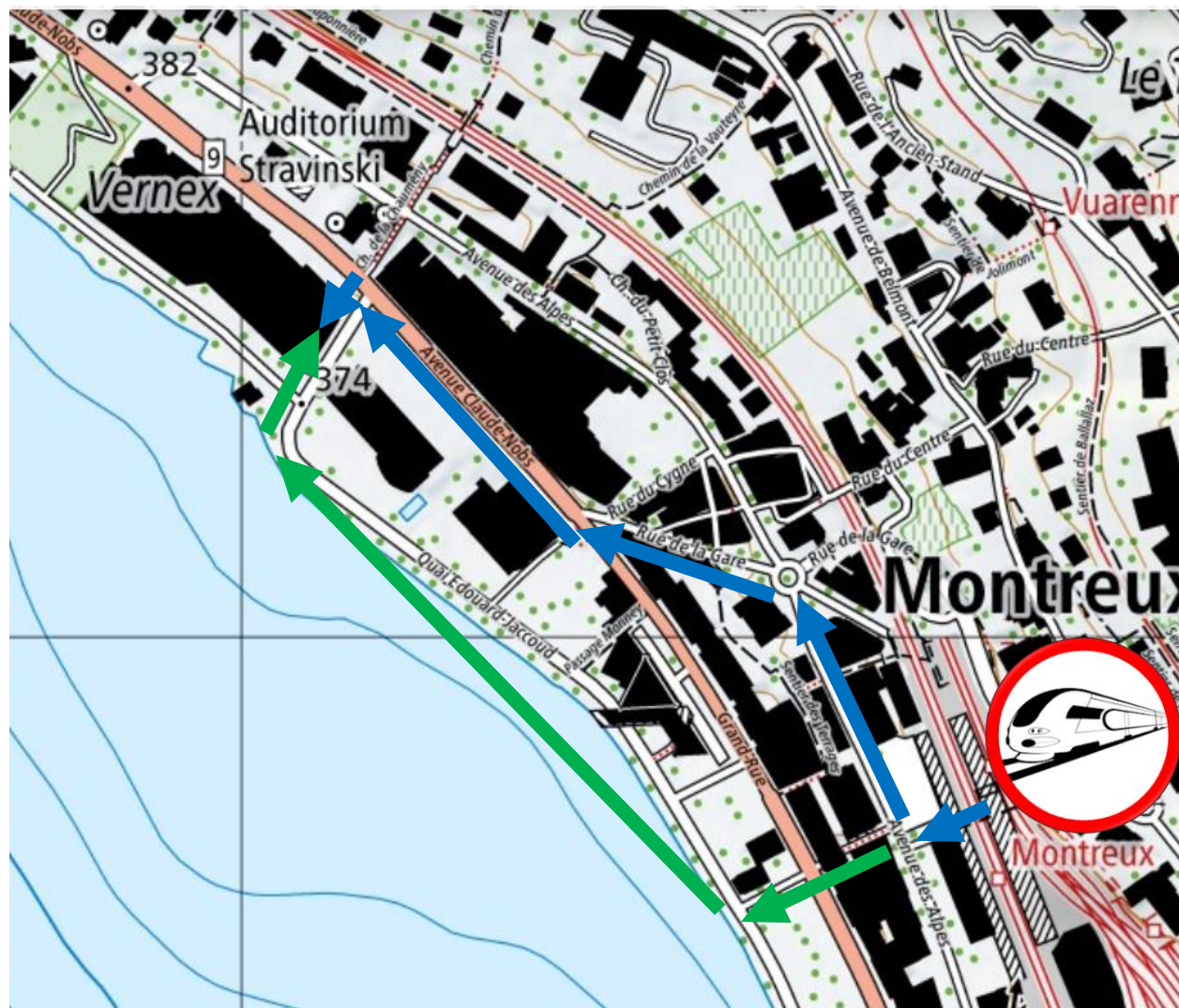

How to get from the train station to the 2m2c & the Miles Davis Hall?

The fastest route (8 minutes walk)

From the main passageway under the railways, in the middle of the train station, go down the staircase. You find yourself in the Avenue des Alpes. Turn right and follow the street until the roundabout. Turn left on the road going slightly down. You are on the Avenue Claude-Nobs. Turn right and follow the road westwards. On your right is the Fairmont Montreux Palace. Just after the Palace, on your left you see a great building. It is the Montreux Music & Convention Center, or “2m2c”. Turn left on the road just before the 2m2c, and enter through the first great entrance, above which you see a purple “Welcome” sign.

More picturesque route (9 minutes, with staircases)

Alternatively, if your luggage is not too heavy, you can keep going down the next staircase (slightly on the right from the entrance of the train station). On the Grand-Rue, you cross the gardens and arrive on the lakeside. You turn right and follow the lakeside westwards. When the path turns to the right again, you follow it up along the big building (2m2c) and stop just before you reach the Avenue Claude-Nobs. On your left is the entrance to the Miles Davis.
